Murdoch Childrens Research Institute

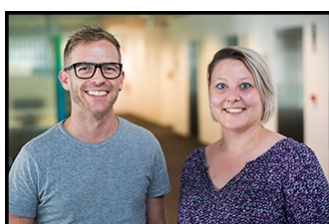

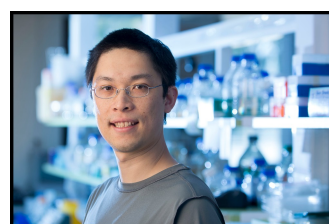
7th Lorne Infection and Immunity Conference
